Recently UP lecturer Dr Horn Rithvitou documented two of his cases treated in the UP Dental Hospital. The first case involved the aesthetic restoration ofseverely decayed upper incisor teeth. Three teeth were treated with Zirconium crowns,and one was restored with a composite layering technique. Dr Vitou was

able to bring the teeth back to their original beauty. The patient was very satisfied with the result and is now very confident to smile again. The second case involved the replacement and interproximal extension of an old restoration, as there was new dental caries between the teeth. With a meticulous approach and doing the treatment under rubber dam, an excellent result was achieved,

UP PHARMACY, MEDICAL AND DENTAL STUDENTS JOINED SOMA GROUP TO PROVIDECOMMUNITY HEALTH SERVICES



A group of UP students consists of one pharmacy student, two medical students and one dental student joined Soma Group to Siem Reap from January 21 to January 23, 2022 to provide community health services to people living in Run Ta Ek eco-village. Pharmacy student was conducting health education on hand hygiene and body hygiene, whereas dental student was conducting oral health hygiene and education to about 250 elementary school students. At the same time, two senior medical students were conducting health checkup andconsultation to about 50 people living in that village. These community health services were part of Soma's Initiatives to contribute back to the society and make impact to improve Cambodian society.

These health services meet the needs of the community in term of health services, where there are not health services in that community. Through Soma Group, UP will provide more health services to the community in the future. So far, UP has joined Soma Group to conduct several health education, consultation and checkup to people living in various parts of Cambodia.



FoP currently provides undergraduate program, bachelor of pharmacy. 6 batches of students have been graduated so far. At the same time FoP has been prepared to open master degree at UP both master of medical biology and pharmaceutical sciences by following the national curriculum. Luckily, MoH team had visited and evaluated our faculty capacity such as human resources, laboratories, teaching resources.

Even during covid-19 pandemic, UP pharmacy has not been stopped developing. It is investing in its laboratories with an average amount of about 70,000.00 US\$ per year in the last three years and continue to invest more to improve laboratories Capacity. UP Pharmacy has collaborations in research and practice for students with both local and international partners. UP pharmacy is trying to reach International quality via Teaching and Learning using UPOP, recognized by MOEYS, MPTC as best in Cambodia. With corrected recommendations from MoH team, UP pharmacy will try to improved its weakness. We believe that UP pharmacy will be allowed to open its master programs very soon.

FACULTY OF PHARMACY IS READY TO WELCOME HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES



UP pharmacy is one of the potential school of pharmacy in Cambodia. It is the only school of pharmacy which is a member of International Pharmaceutical Federation (FIP), in world school list of school of pharmacy, A member of ASEAN Association of Schools of Medical Technology(AASMT), A member of ASEAN PharmNET and a member of Asian Association of School of Pharmacy (AASP). UP Pharmacy has collaborations in research and practice for students with both local and international partners. UP has produced 6 batches of pharmacy with the highest passing rate in the national exit exam and high employment rate. Batch 1= 100% passing rate at the national exit exam, as of school graduation day 74% were employed, batch 2=98.92% passing rate, employment rate 77.42%, batch 3=98.79%, employment rate 98.80%, batch 4=97.67%, employment rate 92.59%, ...etc.

During Covid-19 pandemic, UP pharmacy is keeping investing its lab capacity to provide a full opportunity for students to practice and also ready to open its master program. Every year, we regularly welcome students to our campus. Any questions related to pharmacy study, all high school graduate can reach our information center or faculty of pharmacy. SCIENCE RESEARCH PROGRAM ORGANIZED A SPECIAL SEMINAR

"HEAVY METAL CONTAMINATION AND HUMAN HEALTH IMPLICATIONS IN THE CHAN THNAL RESERVOIR, CAMBODIA"



On Wednesday, 26th January 2022, the Science Research Program, the University of Puthisastra organized a special seminar under the title of "Heavy Metal Contamination and Human Health Implications in the Chan ThnalReservoir, Cambodia" via an online platform (Zoom Meeting). The honor invited speaker of the seminar was Mr. CHHEANG Lita, the Ph.D.Candidate in Analytical Chemistry at the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, Thailand with Mr. BE Sokkeang, Program Coordinator and Lecturer of Science Research Program, the University of Puthisastra as the facilitator. This special seminar was organized to share information on heavy metal contaminations in the Chan Thnal reservoir, Cambodia, science research experience and to raise awareness about the effect of heavy metals on human health.

After the special seminar ended, all participants have learned and gained a lot of knowledge and experience from our invited speaker as well as from other participants related to heavy metal contamination in the Chan Thnal reservoir and its effect on human health.

CLERKSHIP OF MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY STUDENTS



After the completion of both theory and practical work in the laboratories of the University of Puthisastra for the first semester in the academic year 2021-2022, the associate degree students in Medical Laboratory Technology of the Faculty of Health Sciences and Biotechnology have been doing clerkship at the laboratories of partner hospitals and institutes in Phnom Penh. Recently, the Department of Laboratory Sciences has organized and sent the 3rd year, batch 9 students, to conduct clerkship at hospitals such as National Pediatric Hospital and Preah Ket Mealea Hospital focusing on Hematology - Blood Clotting and Bacteriology which are linked with previously studied theories in university.

Meanwhile, students will learn more about the real situation, practice, and operation during the clerkship, as well as rehearsal communication skills and other soft skills which will be beneficial for their future workplace.

TWO MEDICAL INTERNS PROVIDED GENERAL MEDICAL CHECK-UP

TO VILLAGERS IN A REMOTE AREA OF SIEM REAP PROVINCE DURING SOMA GROUP ANNUAL STAFF RETREAT



Two medical interns, Mr. Yob Meanleap and Ms. Tep Phyrak, had the opportunity to join the annual SOMA Group Staff Retreat. As part of the trip agenda, SOMA arranged for a general health check-up of 50 adult villagers living in Run Ta Ek, a remote village in Siem Reap. A general health check-up includes checking vital signs, performing a general physical examination and checking the blood glucose level. Some of the villagers were found to have high blood pressure and/or high blood sugar levels. UP medical interns recommended them to seek medical attention at the local health center or referral hospital for further investigation and management. Mr. Meanleap mentioned that it was the first time that MD students had a chance to join the Annual Retreat and he was looking forward to having more MD students join in the future.

Ms. Phyrak added: "I am so happy to have joined this trip! I have met staff of SOMA Group from different company's background. I am excited that we talked and shared experiences under the leadership of SOMA."

MORE MANIKINS DELIVERED TO THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE









Three different types of manikins were recently delivered to the Faculty of Medicine. The multipurpose male care simulator enables students to perform rectal examination, appreciate prostate enlargement, nodules and benign and malignant tumors of the gland. Students also can learn to examine penis and scrotum with tumors. This manikin also allows students to learn how to insert a urinary catheter.

The advanced pelvic examination and gynecology simulator comes with many accessories that enable the students to perform bimanual examination, speculum exam and cytology sampling. The accessories can provide a wide range of simulation case scenarios, such as vaginal discharge, cancer, uterine fibroids, polyps, polycystic ovaries. The pediatric choking manikin enables also to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation. These newly arrived manikins will add to the ones previously acquired for the pre-hospital training of the medical students.

TRAINING ON HEALTH SCREENING IN THE UP DENTAL HOSPITAL



In 2021 batch 3 senior dental students Ly Huntean, Leang Sokchea and leng Sivgech completed their thesis on "Health Screening in the UP Dental Hospital". They are due to defend the thesis very soon. The results were very interesting, as over a one year period they identified many cases of medical problems among dental patients, some of which the patients did not know about. These included cases of hypertension, diabetes, obesity and low oxygen levels in the blood. Where appropriate, the patients were advised to see their medical doctor for follow-up.

We, like many overseas dental schools, believe that dental clinics can be an appropriate place for health screening, as it not only ensures that the dental and oral surgical treatment can be carried out safely, but it also alerts patients to underlying medical problems that they may not know about, especially if they do not visit their doctor regularly.

Recently Huntean helped conduct training for year 4 dental students on how to conduct health screening. These students will shortly begin to treat patients in our dental hospital. They learned about how to measure of blood pressure, blood glucose, BMI, waist circumference and how to screen for diabetes symptoms.

During the training the students were able to practice the procedures on each other. Thank you Huntean for your help in training our students to be competent and safe dental practitioners.

GUEST SPEAKER OPENS EYES OF DENTAL STUDENTS TO WHAT RESEARCH IS ALL ABOUT



Recently UP senior dental students were treated to a special online lecture by visiting academic Dr Phan Sok (MD, MPH, MSW, PhD (Canada)). Dr Phan Sok works at the University of Toronto and has an exceptional education background, as well as being an innovative health researcher and an experienced health administrator. His research interests include health related quality of life, social determinants of health, health quality, infectious diseases, age-related illnesses, mental health and health behaviours and outcomes.

During his lecture he talked about his own journey in health research, and about why it is important for them to know about research. He also shared withstudents the steps of conducting research and how to write a paper forpublication. One of the students in class, Im Puthisa said afterwards "Dr Phan Sok was very good at explaining research in a way we could easily understand, and he motivated us to work hard on our theses". GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN IMPLANT DENTISTRY - FINAL EXAMS



The most challenging part of the Graduate Diploma in Implant Dentistry was the final exam which was conducted with both a written and oral (viva voce) examination. The written exam took 3 hours with 5 challenging questions to test the students' ability in analyzing cases, making with evidence-based treatment plans and discussing important issues such as alternative treatment options, prevention and implant maintenance. Students' answers had to be backed up with reference to the latest scientific literature. This is quite new for Cambodian courses. The 30 minute viva voce (oral) was conducted through zoom, one student at a time. There was 1 Cambodian examiner (Dr. Tak Ranuch) and 2 Australian examiners for each session. Seven group 1 students were assessed by A/Prof Kent Yeun and A/Prof Gorge Pal and seven others by Dr. Cecilia So and Dr. Po Lu. Adjunct Prof Patrick Tseng was also there to facilitate the exam process.

The results of the exams revealed a few outstanding candidates with top scores. Dr Patrick commented that they were worthy of distinction and up to the standard of the top Australian students. Overall the examiners were very satisfied with the students' performance. We hope that the Australian team will continue their support for another batch later in 2022.

Apart from the exams, students are compiling their clinical log books and the clinical case reports which also must be submitted in order to graduate. The deadline is the end of March. After that, the final scores for the whole program will be calculated and released. Once all of the cases are assessed as satisfactory, the reports will then be printed and bound, and these hard copies will be kept in the library. Congratulations to the successful candidates – UP is proud of you!
