














The University of Puthisastra & IELTS are pleased to announce a strengthening of their long-term cooperation with IELTS benchmarking of the UP English Degree.

Set to launch in Semester 1, 2023, the UP English Degree is a 4-year degree program providing students with the necessary English language skills for sustainable employability and high-level career prospects. 50% Scholarship available for this program!

UP is a valued member of the global IELTS Alliance Program after signing an MoU with IELTS in January 2021.

The UP English Degree will be benchmarked at the exit point by IELTS. This means students graduating from the UP English Degree will have an IELTS overall score of 6.5 with no individual band score less than 6. This score of 6.5 with no band score less than 6 is generally required to apply for the majority of Bachelor and Master's degree programs at international universities in Australia, New Zealand, USA, UK and Ireland.

6.5 with no band score less than 6 is also the score required to be awarded any of the prestigious Australia Award, New Zealand, Chevening or Japan Development scholarships.

In some ASEAN countries such as the Philippines, the majority of IELTS test takers need a score to be able to work overseas in the nursing, elderly care and medical sectors in countries such as Australia, the UK, Canada and the United States.

Therefore, UP English Degree graduates will be uniquely positioned to study, work or migrate at institutions, employers or locations of their choosing.

UP & IELTS have launched a new promotional campaign around the UP campus to encourage those studying English and dreaming of a further international study or careers to prepare for and sit an IELTS test.

IELTS is the world's most popular high stakes English language test with over 4 million tests taken in the last year and over 11,000 institutions worldwide – including universities, schools, employers, immigration authorities and professional bodies, including medical and nursing associations globally – recognise IELTS as an international benchmark of English language capacity.

IN DECEMBER 2022, UNIVERSITY OF PUTHISASTRA HAS SIGNED MOU WITH THREE DIFFERENT PROJECTS FROM NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF SINGAPORE



Due to the pandemic, numerous mission trips and community engagement projects had to be put on hold. However, now that the situation has much improved, University of Puthisastra is starting to resume its normal collaboration. Therefore, in order to further global collaboration, joint projects, and exchange activities, the University of Puthisastra and three different projects from the National University of Singapore decided to sign the renewal of their Memorandum of Understanding as follows:

- 1. Project Lokun, signed on December 5, 2022, is a student-initiated Overseas Community Involvement Project (OCIP) that was first founded in December 2007. It is a biannual medical mission trip that serves 4 villages Toul Makak, Takeo Village, Buon Village and Prey Omal in Pursat, Cambodia. It has always been Project Lokun's vision to establish ties with a Cambodian Medical University to achieve sustainability. Project Lokun traditionally organises 2 medical mission trips a year, usually in May and December.
- 2. Project Sothea, signed on December 5, 2022 is a student-initiated and student-led project conducted by first and second year medical students from the NUS Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine. Since 2010, medical professionals from across multiple disciplines and various organisations have joined the project for the annual trips to Battambang. Project Sothea has been operating in Dangkut Thnong and Anlong Svay since 2010, but will be shifting the focus to two new villages, Srae Ou and Roung 1. The project conducts health screenings annually to help villagers who present with acute or chronic diseases. ProjectSothea recognises the importance of preventive healthcare and thus focuses on health education by working with local schools and Village Health Support Groups (VHSG). These topics range from handwashing, healthy diet to dengue prevention and exercising.
- 3.Project Sa'Bai, signed on December 8, 2022 is a student-initiated Overseas Community Involvement Project (OCIP) that was first founded in December 2006. It is an annual medical mission trip that serves 3 schools (as of December 2022): Don Bosco Phum Chreh School, Don Bosco Teuk Thla School and Don Bosco Vocational Training Center for Girls in Toul Kork, and 3 areas: Phum Ches Village, Teuk Thla Commune and Wat Champa in Chbar Ampov District. Sa'Bai organises 1 medical mission trip per year, in May. During the ceremony, Professor Ian Findlay advised volunteer students to remember that this initiative is crucial in connecting students across borders, so they should all seize the chance to appreciate and enjoy exchanging and learning from each other's cultures and experiences. The international friendship has to continue even after the project is over. Professor Ian also shared some prerequisites that the students should be aware of before beginning the upcoming projects.

THE 4TH PHARMACEUTICAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE, THE BIGGEST PHARMACEUTICAL CONFERENCE IN CAMBODIA. 4TH PHARMACEUTICAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE



The Faculty of Pharmacy of University of Puthisastra, organized by the 4th Pharmaceutical Research Conference, would take place over two days from December 10 to 11, 2022, Hall B of the University of Puthisastra.

The conference was chaired by HE Ban Botta, President of Pharmacist Council of Cambodia and Under-Secretary of State of the Ministry of Health, Prof. Ian Findlay, President and Vice Chancellor of the University of Puthisastra, and Dr. Chea Sin, Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Puthisastra.

The conference brings together over 150 pharmacists from various fields to share and learn from each other. Speakers were invited from the Ministry of Health, the private sector, community pharmacies, pharmaceutical distributors, pharmaceutical industry, educational institutions, hospital pharmacies, consumer protection institutions, non-governmental institutions, legal institutions and biomedical institutions.

This program is organized for the following purposes:

- 1. Encourage researchers, pharmacists, and students to share their findings in the conference.
- 2. Share knowledge, experience, best practices, research projects, creative ideas and the success of profession.
- 3. Get the latest information on research capabilities in Cambodia needed for pharmacists.
- 4. Share recommendations, opinions and updates to improve pharmacy profession in Cambodia, both regionally and globally.
- 5. Prepare students to acquire the skills needed and respond to current and future market needs.
- 6. Build good relationships among pharmacy family in Cambodia.

The 4th Pharmaceutical Research Conference program presents and shares knowledge related to research in the field of pharmacy as follows:

- 1. Pharmacy education
- 2. Pharmaceutical chemistry and pharmacology
- 3. Pharmaceutical technology
- 4. Clinical pharmacy
- 5. Medical biology
- 6.Pharmacognosy
- 7. Public health



11 national and international guest speakers participated in the conference, including from Thailand, Bangladesh, and Japan. In addition, there were 13 oral presentations, and 25 poster presentations.

We can see the best pharmacy conference ever with the most oral presentation and poster presentations.

The 4th Pharmaceutical Research Conference (the 4th PRC) was the first International Conference on Pharmaceutical Research in Cambodia. It was held between December 10-11, 2022 by the Faculty of Pharmacy in the form of a hybrid conference. In Total, around two hundred people participated in this conference. Among those participants, fifteen pharmacy staff helped in organizing the conference, seventy-five students did poster presentations, four students did oral presentations, forty-two students participated as volunteers, and ninety pharmacy students participated as participants.

During the conference, researchers, pharmacists, academicians, and pharmacy students from Thailand, Japan, Bangladesh, and Cambodia shared their research findings, and discussed ways forward to improve pharmaceutical research quality and encouraged researchers and students to conduct more research.

The 4th PRC 2022 provided participants a great opportunity to meet up with both national and international researchers who are working in different areas of pharmacy and establish a scientific network.

The 4th Pharmaceutical Research Conference was seen as the biggest research conference in the pharmacy field. The evaluation committee, sub-organizing committee had selected 7 best poster presentations and 4 best oral presentations. The Best Poster and Oral Presentation goes to:

THE DEPUTY DEAN FOR CLINICAL AFFAIRS OF THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE TOOK PART IN THE PROVISION OF ADVANCED PEDIATRIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING AT ANGKOR HOSPITAL FOR CHILDREN

The Deputy Dean for Clinical Affairs of the Faculty of Medicine, Dr. Prom Vireak, was part of a team of 11 instructors who provided a 3-day training on Advanced Pediatric Life Support (APLS) to medical doctors and health professionals from Cambodian public and private clinics/hospitals at Angkor Hospital for Children in Siem Reap Province.

24 medical doctors/health professional from 9 provinces took part in the training. The instructors were qualified APLS trainers whose training was provided in the past by an Australian Team.

The 3-day training included presentations, skills practice, case scenarios and workshops. The skills practice allowed the trainees to practice in thoracenthesis, chest drain, neurological assessment, airway and breathing management. Case scenarios included Advanced Cardiac Arrest Management, Trauma Scenario and Seriously ill scenario. The workshops ranged from interpretation of radiology images to blood gas, septic child and fluid disturbances.

Every participant had a chance to practice all the simulation. At the end of the training the trainees passed exams (simulation skills and MCQs).











MEMBERS OF THE MEDICAL STUDENTS' SIMULATION CLUB PROVIDE TRAINING

In the recent visit to the Headquarters and the Factory of Arun Cambodia's Natural Water, six medical student club members, along with Faculty of Medicine staff, provided training on basic life support, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation and choking management, to 25 company staff.

9 of the students were also involved in the prehospital training for MD year 4 and 5 students at UP campus. They were placed in different skill stations (Basic Life Support, Wound Suture Skill, Workshop on Chest X-ray reading, basic physical examination skill). The trainer students were enthusiastic to provide the training to their colleagues.
