TRAINING ON KJELDAHL ANALYSIS CONDUCTED BY FACULTY OF PHARMACY







On 23 March 2023, Faculty of Pharmacy conducted a training session on how to use and operate a new Kjeldahl analysis apparatus which has just been purchased.

The Kjeldahl is an important analytical method widely used to determine the nitrogen and protein contents in a wide range of samples such as food, feed, beverage, plant, soils, petroleum, etc. This method has many benefits over other protein analysis methods, such as:

- 1. Accuracy: The Kjeldahl method is highly accurate and provides precise results, making it one of the most reliable methods for protein analysis.
- 2. Flexibility: The Kjeldahl method can be used to determine the protein content in a wide range of samples, including food, animal feed, and agricultural samples
- 3. Cost-effectiveness: The equipment required Kjeldahl method is relatively inexpensive, and the running cost of the method is also low
- 4. Sensitivity: The Kjeldahl method is extremely sensitive, allowing for the accurate detection of trace amounts of proteins.
- 5. Standardization: The Kjeldahl method is a standardized method, which means that the results obtained are comparable across different laboratories.

A patient came to UP dental hospital complaining about her previous linked crown that she was not satisfied with. Problems included the poor shape of the teeth, the color not being aesthetic, and the black staining at the gum line caused by the crown.

After having a thorough examination and treatment plan by Dr. Horn Rithvitou, one of UPDH dentists, a plan was made to replace the old linked crowns with new Zirconium crowns. After received the new crowns the patient the patient was very happy with the appearance, and said she had the confidence to smile again. YOU-SMILE I-SMILE



The 'You-Smile I-Smile' team is a student-led club that focuses on providing care for children with special needs and they have been very active this month working with CIPO to provide care at three different schools for children with special needs. The new dental unit donated by the Ivoclar CSR project was put to good use and the children particularly benefited from ultrasonic scaling that wasn't possible for us to do before.

Demonstrations for topical fluorides: One of the roles of CIPO is to support the Oral Health Bureau (Ministry of Health) in advancing the cause for access to Universal Health Care for oral health. For this reason Dr Tida and her team accompanied the Oral Health Bureau in conducting Training of Trainers so that nurses and midwives learned to place Fluoride Varnish (FV) on preschool children in Siem Reap.

Our major challenge in sustaining this activity is the supply chain of FV and so we continue to troubleshoot around making sure that the government supply of FV can be distributed in a timely manner.

UP VOLUNTEERS STUDENTS FOR MALARIA PROJECT









The University of Puthisastra collaborates with PMI VectorLink which is working on the Malaria project (malaria control program). Currently, they are recruiting volunteer students from the Faculty of Health Sciences and Biotechnology; Bachelor Degree of Science Research (BSC), Associate Degree of Medical Laboratory (ADL), and Bridging Bachelor Degree in Medical Laboratory Technology (BBL) to join the training and assist in the collaboration project. The project mainly focuses on mosquito dissection/mosquito identification by using ELISA and PCR techniques. BSC/ADL/BBL successful candidates will gain an opportunity in learning about mentioned methods and be a part of the PMI VectorLink Project or future chance to work with PMI VectorLink.

Prof Callum Durward, Dean of Dentistry at UP, was invited to travel to IMU to be an examiner in Community Dentistry, and to give a lecture on "alternative approaches to managing dental caries in children in low income settings". During the lecture Prof Callum was able to talk about some of the innovative programs for infants and children in Cambodia (including the Smile Cambodia and Healthy Kids Cambodia projects), and the new draft National Oral Health Activity Plan 2023-2030 which is currently being developed.

The Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry at IMU, Prof Seow Liang Lin, discussed the possibility of cooperating in the future on postgraduate education, including implantology, endodontics and prosthodontics, all of which they currently offer.

IMU is regarded by many as the top private health sciences university in Malaysia. Prof Callum was impressed with the standard of education, and the state-of-the-art facilities. IMU has an innovative program where after year 3 they send about half of their students overseas to complete their degrees at partner universities in Canada, NZ, Australia and the UK.

INTRAOSSEOUS DRIVER AND NEEDLES DELIVERED TO THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE

The delivery of the intraosseous drive and needles will allow to organize another important practical simulation training station in the Pre-hospital Training Course for UP medical students. The IO needle is inserted in the bone's hard cortex and into the soft marrow interior.

IO access is used in emergency cases when an intravenous line cannot be placed. It is an effective route for fluid resuscitation, drug delivery and blood sampling.

UP FACULTY SPEAKS AT IOS MID YEAR CONVENTION IN VIETNAM

On the 11th of April 2023, the 19th mid-year convention of the Indian Orthodontic society was organized at Pullman Saigon Hotel in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. The mid-year convention is an annual event for the Indian Orthodontic Society (IOS) and it is organized every year at a different country. The IOS is one of the strongest and most progressive orthodontic associations in the world with more than 6000 life members and 12500 student members actively contributing to various events throughout the year. The IOS started as a Study Group in Bombay, now Mumbai, way back in the year 1963. It was formally established as the INDIAN ORTHODONTIC SOCIETY on Friday the 5th October 1965 by seven founder members. The late Dr. H.D. Merchant was the founder President and Dr. Naishadh Parikh the Founder Secretary and treasurer. The Indian Orthodontic Society held it's first Conference in the year 1967 at New Delhi with a scientific session. This was followed regularly by annual conferences every year, which are attended by a large number of Orthodontists from within the country and abroad.

The IOS also has a mid year convention every year, sometimes overseas in association with a sister international organization. This year the mid year convention was organized with support from the Vietnam Orthodontic Association. The convention was organized wonderfully by the Organizing Chairman Dr Sarabjeet Singh with support from the organizing secretary Dr Anshu Kalra. There was a full day scientific session organized by the Scientific Chairman Dr Sukhdeep Singh Kahlon and Dr. Anand Marya the UP Head of Orthodontics was invited as a special guest and asked to deliver a guest lecture on the management of Complex class III malocclusions. The meeting was presided by the respected President of the Indian Orthodontic Society- Dr Balvinder Singh Thakkar and the honorable President of the Vietnam Orthodontic Association- Professor Dr. Dong Khac Tham. Also gracing the occasion with their presence were the President-elect of the IOS Dr Jayesh Rahalkar and the chief editor of the Journal of the IOS Dr. Santosh Ramegowda.
